Richardson & Robinson – Chapter 4: Men, Masculinities and Feminism

- Men's Studies: origins in men's movements
 - View traditional gender roles as restrictive for BOTH W & M
 - o 'Gender' ≠ singular
- Men's Movements men against sexism
 - **Mythopoetic** Liberate men from modern feminine constraints
 - Jungian Identify the masculine & feminine components of the unconscious mind
 - Gay Challenge traditional notions of masculinity & femininity
 - 'Hegemonic masculinity' relationships b/t men & women involve certain power structure, M = dominant & W = subordinate
 - Subordinate masculinities = homosexuals
- Waves of Men's Studies:
 - 1st Wave (1970's): Hegemonic masculinity White, western, middle-class, heterosexual masculinity = universal experience
 - 2nd Wave (1980's): Diversity Working-class, black, & gay masculinities = Multifaceted experiences
 - **3rd Wave** (1990's): Poststructuralism Masculinity = socially constructed & fluid
 - **Multiple Masculinities**: Plural ≠ single fixed pattern
 - Differing over: Time, Space, Context
 - Variables: Race/ethnicity, Class, Age
- Result: The 'crisis of masculinity' inside & outside
- Response:
 - **Pro-feminist** men: Challenge the notion that you must be the subject of oppression or inequalities to be considered a "feminist", Support feminism reforms
 - Anti-feminist men: Reject at least one of the feminist principles, Oppose women's equality, & Preserve masculinity from "pollution" or "invasion"

- Problem w/ Hegemonic Masculinity: Most men do NOT fit model
 - Are most men complicit in sustaining it?
 - Although men benefit from oppressive structure
 - Some men change patriarchal system because....
 - Beneficiaries can SEE oppression & how it affects SHARED lives
 - Heterosexual men are committed to women & DESIRE to create more EQUALITY
 - Heterosexual men are NOT all the SAME & some may SUFFER under hegemonic system

- CHANGE is already happening & it is impractical to cling to old hegemonic system
- Heterosexual men have the capacity to CARE & certain personal circumstances bring it out
- Claim: Traditional understandings of heterosexual masculinity are AFFIRMED & AUTHENTICATED by society through: ideologies, discourse, representations, & material practices
 - $\circ~$ 'Hegemonic masculinity' = **Dominant sexuality** \rightarrow naturalized \rightarrow Heterosexuality = NORM
 - o Subordinate masculinities: Effeminate, unassertive, or homosexual men
 - Sources: Sport, intimacy, emotions, embodiment, violence, education, fatherhood, & relationships → "heteronormativity"
 - Process: Men put down the OTHER [women & gays] → Rid themselves of BOTH [femininity, & homosexuality] → Misogyny [hatred of women] & Homophobia [negative attitudes towards homosexuals]
- **Construction:** of heterosexual-homophobic-hegemonic masculinities = **Traditional Sports**
 - o Globalization of dominant masculine sexuality & power
 - HOW: Images constructed [Ideal = dominant masculinity] & systematically promoted [competitive sport]
 - Problem: Ideal = homogenous
 Men ≠ homogenous
