# Implications of Gendered Media

- 2. Normalize Violence Against Women
  - Media may not *cause* violence, but mounting evidence supports the claim that it contributes to increasing male violence
  - Commonplace violence in media leads us to think that violence is acceptable & normal

#### Normalize Violence Against Women

- Video Games
  - Watching & engaging in violence
- Music videos
- Pro wrestling

"Studies have shown that men who watch music videos and pro wrestling are more likely to believe that forcing a partner to have sex is sometimes okay." (Wood, 286)

#### Normalize Violence Against Women

- Relationship between mediated violence & real-life violence:
  - Social learning theory
    - We engage in behaviors that are rewarded and avoid behaviors that are punished
  - Cognitive development theory
    - We use role models to base our behaviors and identities on
  - Symbolic interactionism
    - Social views shape individual identities

## Social Foundations of Gendered Violence

## Causes:

- Individual psychology
- Social circumstance

 Focus: which media factors cultivate tolerance for violence towards women and those who do not conform to conventional sex/gender roles

## The Normalization of Violence in the Media

- Sexual violence in the media is linked to increased tolerance and approval of violence in real-life relationships
  - Violence is customary in films, TV, music, & video games

## • 'Erotica' =

- Depicts consensual activities that are desired by and pleasurable to all parties
- Does not cultivate violence in relationships

## The Normalization of Violence in the Media

### 'Pornogrpahy' =

- Not simply sexually explicit material
- Favorably shows subordination & degradation of individuals by presenting sadistic behaviors as pleasurable, pain as enjoyable, & forced sex as positive
- It includes violence against women that may encourage those who consume it to think violence in real relationships is acceptable or normal
